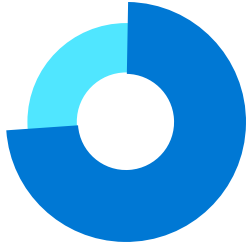

How and where we work has changed



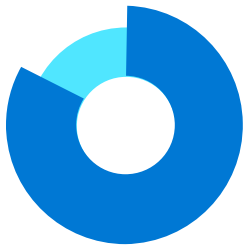
73%

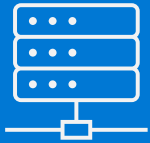
AVD and Windows 365 – Which Tool Where?

Windows 365



Non-Persistent/Low concurrency (Windows Multisession) or Published apps



Infrastructure Team leading – typically prefer to engineer and run their own solution



Existing in-house or Outsourced VDI skills/operations



Wants to pay for what they consume



Looking to leverage existing Citrix/VMWare investment



Mid-concurrency where business case between single session PUPM or Windows Multisession consumption model needs to be made in partnership with the customer



Personalised desktop requirement



EUC/Workplace Team Leading – ability to centre management on MEM



No access to in-house/outsource VDI skills/operations



Wants predictability of cost



No long-term Citrix or VMWare commitment
